

## Compliance with Section 889 of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA), 2019

Section 889 of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2019 prohibit the purchase of covered telecommunications equipment and services from vendors who sell products containing spyware. These devices could pose a threat to U.S. security by spying on or disrupting communications within the U.S.<sup>1</sup>
